### **4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Docks Ribbon Cutting**

**Mount Dora, Fla. (July 7, 2020)** – City Councilmembers along with Mayor Cathy Hoechst joined City leaders and staff for the re-opening of the 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Docks with an official ribbon cutting Tuesday morning.

Repair work was completed on the docks in June that included installation of new pipe hinges on the floating docks and pylons used to hold the floating docks in place. In 2019, after several strong storms came through Lake County, the floating docks had broken away from the previous welded hinges, making the docks dangerous and unstable to use or stand on. Extensive work was done on the docks and the City Construction Manager worked diligently with Faden Builders to get the repairs done.

The 4th Avenue Docks is an iconic spot in the city where visitors and residents can visit to watch world famous sunsets on Lake Dora. City Councilmembers supported the efforts to make sure the docks were repaired quickly and safely for everyone to enjoy. Rusty Anchor Tours has resumed using the docks for their boat tours.
