Upon completion of the above application, please submit to Mount Dora Fire Department for review. If the application is complete, meets all of the required ordinances, codes and laws, and the permit fee in the amount of \$100 has been received, a permit will be issued by the Fire Inspector's Office.

REQUIREMENTS FOR A FIREWORKS DISPLAY

Submission of Application

The completed application for a fireworks permit must be submitted to the Mount Dora Fire Department Fire Inspector's Office at least 14 working days prior to the event.

Site Plan Requirements

- Diagrams should be drawn to approximate scale and should contain the information described in this section.
- Display site- identify significant ground features, public right of ways, significant buildings or structures, overhead obstructions, parking areas, and spectator viewing areas.
- Location of fireworks storage areas.
- Fallout area, including dimensions. If over water, explain/provide criteria for prohibiting watercraft into the fallout area.
- North arrow.
- Likely wind direction.
- Location of significant roadways, including access and control points.
- Traffic plans indicating the flow of vehicles into and out of the site before and after the display.
- Location of emergency vehicle staging area and access routes.

Discharge Details

Diagrams shall be prepared and submitted to illustrate the general arrangement and size of mortars and the location of shell storage at the discharge site. These diagrams shall include the location of the electrical firing unit.

Event Procedures

A description of the public display event shall be prepared by the sponsor and submitted for review and approval. Event descriptions should include the time and schedule of event(s), attendance estimates, and procedures for the following:

- Communications.
- Weather monitoring.
- Site security.
- Crowd control.
- Emergency forces notification.

Firing Procedures

Operating procedures should be prepared and submitted for review and approval, and contain the following information:

- Identification of operator.
- Copies of applicable display personnel licenses, permits, or certificate of fitness.
- Description of the firing method to be used.

Termination Procedures

A description of the procedures to be taken upon completion of the outdoor display should be prepared and submitted and should contain the following information:

- Procedures for inspecting the discharge site and fallout area for any defective or unexploded fireworks.
- Procedures for disposing of defective fireworks and fireworks materials.

Emergency Procedures

Emergency instructions shall be prepared and submitted for approval. These procedures should include the following information:

- Description of the means of alerting staff of emergencies.
- Identification of the signal and means to notify the display operator, sponsor or both to terminate the loading or firing of fireworks in the event a hazard arises during the outdoor display.
- Identification of the means of notifying public emergency forces.
- Emergency reporting instructions describing the information that shall be provided to emergency operators.
- Effective notification of spectators of conditions affecting their safety. Public address announcements should be used to ensure an orderly spectator response. The following are situations that can be anticipated at an event of this type:
 - Fire
 - Medical emergency
 - Vehicle accident
 - Crowd disturbance
 - Adverse weather conditions

Insurance Requirements

The fireworks operator or event sponsor shall furnish the City with a "Certificate of Insurance" in the amount of \$1,000,000 for each individual claim and \$2,000,000 cumulative, for all claims arising from the same incident or occurrence, with the City named as an additional insured.

Permission of the Land Owner

The application must be signed by the owner of the property where the fireworks display is to take place.
