**Screening of *Lifeline*, *The Untold Story* and Blood Drive to be held in Mount Dora**

**MOUNT DORA, Fla. (May 30, 2018)** – The Mount Dora Community Building will be hosting a screening of *Lifeline*, *The Untold Story* of Saving Pulse Survivors, to bring awareness to the importance of donating blood in our community on Monday, June 11, 2018.

*Lifeline* delivers a never-before-seen perspective of what it took to save the lives of the victims from the Pulse nightclub shooting that unfolded on June 12, 2016 in Orlando, Florida. It is a story about extraordinary people who are forever linked to saving the lives of the victims from one of our nation's worst mass shootings, yet their stories have never been told ... until now.

The one-of-a-kind documentary features Pulse survivors as they learn of anonymous blood donors who are responsible for helping save their lives. Donors of varying ages and backgrounds that the survivors were not even aware existed until it was brought to their attention.

At the screening, The Patrons of the Community Building will be taking donations to help with improvements to the Community Building, including equipment needs so we can continue to bring high-quality productions to Mount Dora.
